Position: Music/Band Teacher Reports to Head of School

General Description

This position includes teaching general music to PreK and Elementary students, as well as Instrumental music to our upper Elementary and Middle School Band students.

Through general music classes, the Music/Band teacher introduces children to create, perform, and appreciate music. The teacher provides students with basic vocal instruction and teaches them about various instruments, including percussion, brass, woodwinds and string instruments. He/she uses hands-on activities to teach children pitch, rhythm and music notation. Like other teachers, the Music/Band teacher is expected to evaluate performance and prepare lesson plans. The Music/Band teacher is required to plan and direct school-wide performances and concerts.

Position Details and Responsibilities

- Teaches Music and Band classes to students in PreK (ages 2-5), Elementary (Kindergarten Grade 5) and Middle School (Grade 6-8).
- Directs the school instrumental performances including band, concert band, and ensembles performances.
- Provides for student participation at extracurricular events, including concerts and school events.
- Organizes, implements, and supports band activities
- Plans, rehearses, and directs musical experiences for the school with a minimum of three performances per school year.
- Cooperates with the school administration in providing music programs for school productions, ceremonies, and, as appropriate, functions that enhance the students' performing experience.
- Oversees scheduling and other arrangements for the rehearsals and concerts in cooperation with the administration
- Maintains an accurate inventory of school-owned instruments.

- Controls the storage and use of school-owned equipment and materials making minor adjustments and required repairs to instruments as needed.
- Submits budget needs annually to the adminstrator in accordance with established timelines and guidelines.
- Orders all supplies and materials necessary for music and band-related activities in accordance with established school procedures.
- Develops and implements plans for the instrumental music program and reports
- Prepares lessons that reflect accommodations for individual student differences
- Plans and uses appropriate instructional and learning strategies, activities, materials, and equipment that reflect understanding of the learning styles and needs of students.
- Creates an environment conducive to learning and appropriate for the physical, social, and emotional development of students.

- Degree in Music Education or related field, master's degree preferred

- Knowledge and experience in instrumental music and band
- Extensive knowledge of musical pedagogy, rehearsal techniques and band concert
- Thorough knowledge of band instruments
- Minimum of 2 years of teaching experience in a K-12 school
