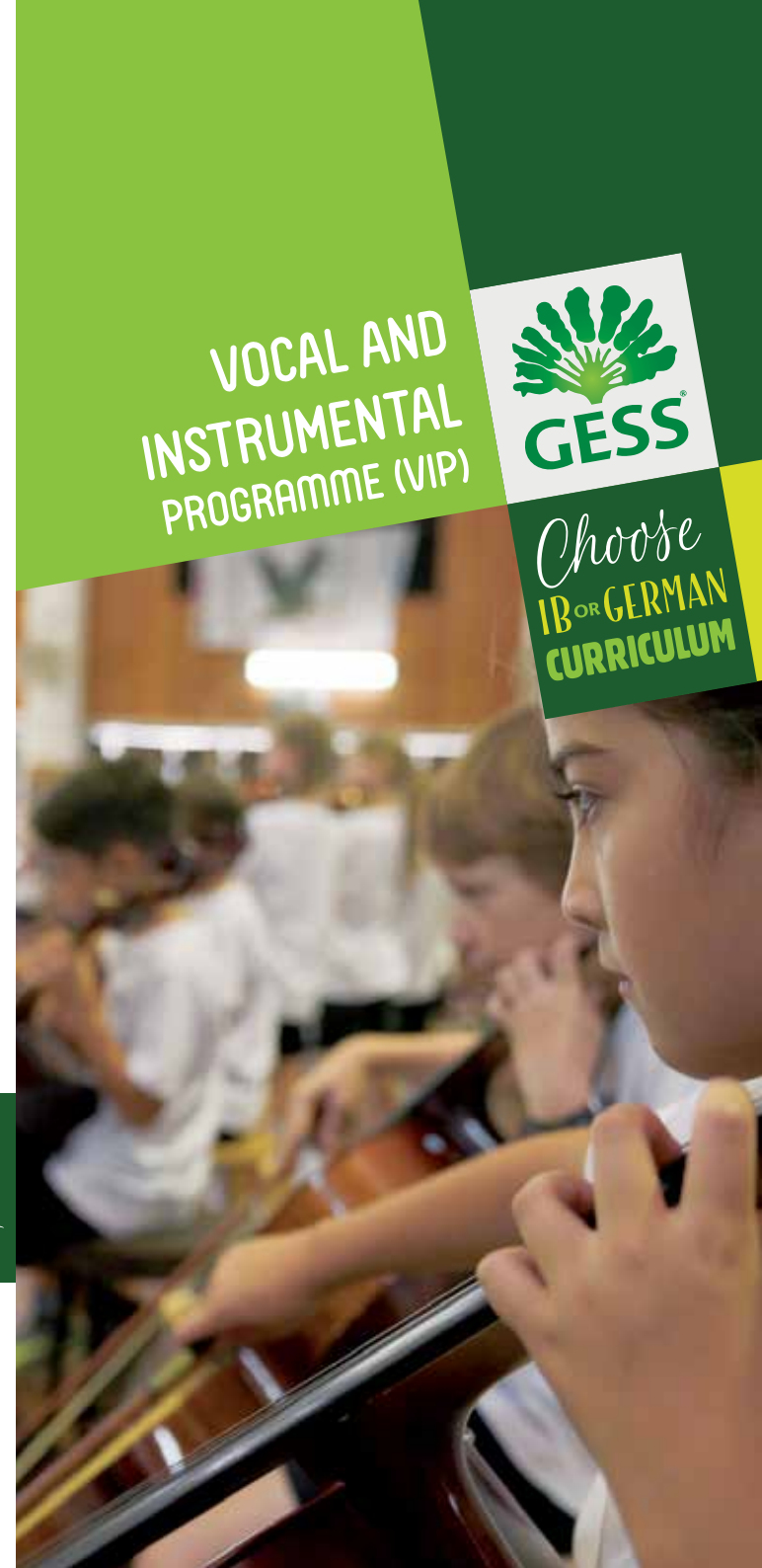

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Lesson Times and Fees

Lessons are offered during the school day and after school. Lessons are offered for a duration of 30 minutes, 45 minutes and 60 minutes.

Students are invoiced during the semester. Please contact the VIP Office for current one-to-one tuition fees. Group lessons of two to three students can be arranged through our VIP Office.

Try an Instrument

At the beginning of the academic year, 'Try an Instrument' is held for students to take part in a trial lesson(s) of 15 minutes with an instrument(s) of their choice. Students and parents are welcome to try as many instruments as they like.

A registration fee is applicable.

Instrument Rental

We have instruments available for rent through the programme. These range from flutes, clarinets, trumpets, strings to keyboards. Additionally, our tutors can advise on purchasing an instrument.

Practice Routines

Practice routines are expected when learning a musical instrument. A commitment to five practice sessions a week is recommended for successful advancement in the chosen instrument. The student practice diary can be referred to for homework.

Ensembles

Students are encouraged to participate in the various ensemble groups which allows the individual to work in a team and make music with others.

This further enhances both their musical and social skills that cut across language and cultural differences to create a musical community.

Examinations

Students wishing to pursue examinations to formally assess skills may arrange this with assistance from their VIP Tutor. Examinations are conducted and moderated externally. Additional fees are payable to the examining body.

Recital Nights and Concerts

Each year, GESS VIP students showcase their instrumental talents to their parents and friends by performing at recital concerts. Ensembles have the opportunity to also perform in various events.
